- (3)-All battles, unless otherwise stated are AXIS vs ALLIES. If needed to balance numbers, tape, stickers, or other such markers are to be utilized in establishing a 'captured vehicle'.
- (4)-Access across rivers **WILL ONLY BE ACROSS BRIDGES.**
- (5)-The battlefield for this battleday is comprised of 8 ZONES. Doug has placed new markers designating each one. These will be utilized for the entire battleday.
